*Atlas**

Small round Parisian Market type.

Small, 1 ½ –2" diameter root.

***Planting:**

Full sun.

Well-drained, deep, loose soil with good moisture-holding capacity

Sow outdoors in early spring - midsummer, ¾ –1" apart, ¼ – ½" deep, in rows 16–24" apart

If needed thin seedlings to ¾ –2" apart,

Plant at 3-week intervals for continuous supply of carrots at their prime.

***Harvest:**

Seedlings start to sprout in 1–3 weeks

Carrots should be fully grown in 70 days and ready to pick for 3 weeks before going bad
