Swiss Chard Bright Lights*

Glossy green or bronze leaves with stems of many colors.

Pods grow 5-5 1/2", purple seeds.





*Planting:

Full sun.

Well-drained soil.

These seeds can be started 5-6 weeks before the last frost date (during early spring) indoors

Plant $\frac{1}{2}$ " deep, 2–3 seeds per cell in 72- or 128-cell flats. Thin to 1–2 plants per cell.

Transplant outside and plant 6 seeds together ½ " deep in rows 12–18" apart. Thin to 4–6"apart for larger leaves

Grows to 10 - 12" height

*Harvest:

After 55 days they are ready to first be harvested.

Cut or snap mature leaves individually. New leaves will grow for multiple harvests
