Verbena

Verbena bonariensis*

Thin stems topped with clusters of 2" heads packed with tiny flowers.

Attracts bees and butterflies





*Planting:

Full sun.

Well-drained soil.

Sow 8-12 weeks indoors before planting outside or direct sow after risk of frost.

Seed is slow to germinate and sensitive to excess moisture, so keep growing medium on the dry side until emergence.

Plant with 18-24" spacing.

Grows to 36-48" height

*Harvest:

90 days till fully grown

Heat tolerant, blooms July to frost

Harvest when the outer 2-4 layers of flowers are open
