

Calendula Flashback Mix

(*Calendula officinalis*)

Bicolor petals. The undersides of the petals are a muted burgundy.

Edible Flowers: Petals of the flowers can be used fresh or dried.

Planting*:

Sow seeds in early spring or fall. For fall planting, ensure seeds experience a period of cold stratification (40°F) for optimal germination.

Plant in full sun to partial shade in rich, well-drained soil. Soil should be moist.

Space seeds 6-12 inches apart, depth of 1/4".

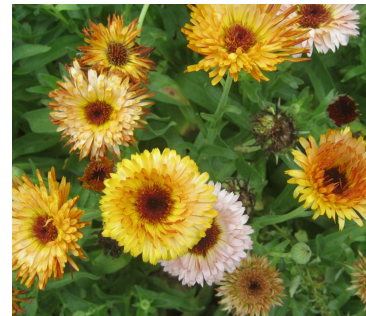
Keep the soil moist until seedlings emerge. Once established, Calendula is low-maintenance.

Harvest*:

50-55 days to maturity

Harvest cut flowers once the bloom is about 50% open.

Harvest edible petals once the flowers are fully open.
