Nasturtium Alaska Mix

(Tropaeolum minus)

Green-and-white foliage

2" single flowers in yellow, crimson, orange, salmon and cherry

Excellent in containers and hanging baskets. Edible flowers, leaves and seed pods





Planting*:

Direct sow after the last frost when soil temperatures reach 55-65°F.

Full sun / partial shade.

Well-draining soil.

Sow seeds 1/2 - 1 inch deep, 8-12 inches apart.

Thin to 3-5 plants in hanging baskets or 10" containers.

Harvest*:

55 - 65 days to maturity

Edible flowers - fully open; edible leaves - at any time
