Annual

Variety: Standard white-flowering form

Lacy white umbels resembling Queen Anne's lace

Planting*:

Sow seeds in early spring or fall. Plant in full sun in well-drained soil.

Surface sow; press lightly into soil.

Harvest*:

75-85 days to bloom

Harvest when umbels are fully open but still fresh.

Edible: No

Cut flower: **Excellent**
