Variety: Species

Large, daisy-like flowers with rosy purple petals and raised copper cones

Planting*:

Sow seeds in fall or early spring. Cold stratification improves germination.

Plant in full sun to partial shade; cover lightly.

Harvest*:

Blooms begin in the second year.

Harvest flowers when fully open.

Edible: **Yes (petals)**

Cut flower: **Yes**
